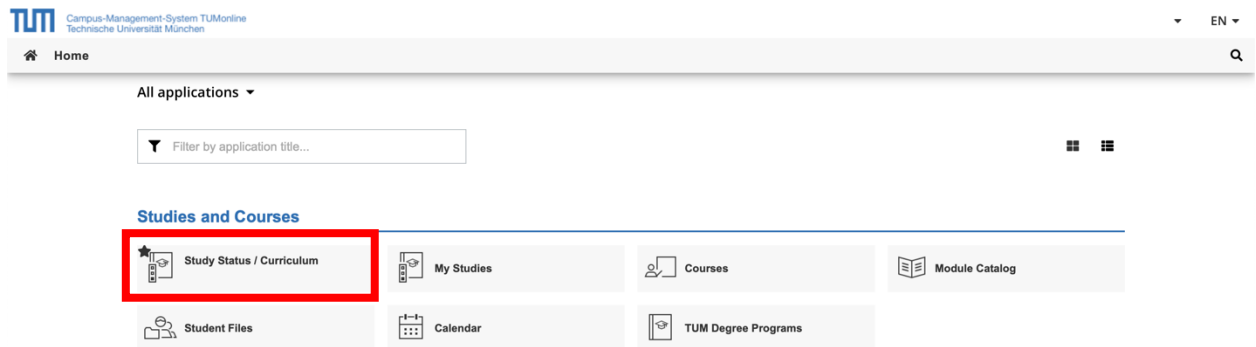


TUMonline Manual
